

Customer Payback Period	<7 months

- Measures installed: LED lighting upgrades throughout the facility
- Incentives covered 56% of project costs
- Space is more inviting, comfortable, refreshed

### How do I participate?

Select a contractor from our approved participating contractor list at coned.com/smallbusiness.

The contractor visits your business and recommends energy-saving upgrades. They'll also tell you how much it will cost and how much Con Edison will cover. You decide if and when the work gets done.

The contractor performs the work.
